<b>TEACHING HOURS</b>	
30 academic hours (1 ac. h. = 45 min.)	
<b>INSTRUCTOR</b>	
Greek Department	
<b>PREREQUISITES</b>	
Completion of Greek I and II. The course is intended for first-year Greek students.	
<b>OBJECTIVE</b>	
To promote conversation in Greek in a more informal environment, as well as to introduce the students to everyday objects, vocabulary and expressions for a variety of topics.	
<b>METHODOLOGY</b>	
The class will be in full Greek immersion. It will primarily consist of conversation, with some TPR, reading, and other elements of the Polis method. Students, as leaders, will present topics of their choice and lead their peers in discussions or activities throughout the semester.	
<b>MODE OF ASSESSMENT</b>	
Each student will lead at least one lunch each semester. Students will be evaluated on their performance in leading the lunch, and on their level of participation (including attendance) in the lunches in general.	
<b>PROGRAM</b>	
The class will be held 2 days per week, Monday and Wednesday 1-1:45.
