OBJECTIVE	
Giving a 15 to 20-minute speech in Biblical Hebrew on a given topic.	
CALENDAR AND ORGANIZATION	
<p>Two to three preparatory speeches in order to train the candidates (no grading): The speeches will be scheduled directly between teacher and students + one final speech.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. An oral assignment for students to present to the whole class within the BH4 regular course in the first or early in the BH5 second semester course. 2. One to two trial speeches (4 hrs. preparation time) based on a fully defined assignment. Both will be scheduled in the second half of the Spring semester, the second one taking place very close to the date of the final speech. These trial Speeches are done individually and each one will last about 30 min. per student, 15 min. for the Speech + 15 min. for a feedback. 3. Final Speech: 45 min. per student, including the speech itself, consultations among the teachers in the jury and the feedback given to the student. The students will also have time for preparation of the assignments allocated to each of them: 4 full hours in the morning of the final speech.
