<b>METHODOLOGY</b>	
The course includes coverage of the four language skills: listening, speaking, reading, and writing. Methodology: Total immersion, Total Physical Response (TPR), participative storytelling, and communicative activities.	
<b>MODE OF ASSESSMENT</b>	
40% assignments, quizzes, and tests. 10% participation and homework. 50% final test. Quizzes and tests can be written or oral.	
<b>PROGRAM</b>	
Subjunctive; verbal forms <sup>1</sup> and 2 direct object pronouns; prepositions; structural “ma”; exclamation; geography; relative clause; conditional sentence.
