OBJECTIVE	
To complete the most important Arabic morphology and syntax; to focus on speaking and expression; to be able to understand the details of a complex or abstract topic and distinguish nuances; to provide the students with the tools to be independent learners.	
METHODOLOGY	
The course includes coverage of the four language skills: listening, speaking, reading, and writing. Methodology: Total immersion, Total Physical Response (TPR), participative storytelling, and communicative activities.	
MODE OF ASSESSMENT	
40% assignments, quizzes, and tests. 10% participation and homework. 50% final test. Quizzes and tests can be written or oral.	
PROGRAM	
Verbal forms 9 and 10; verbs with four-letter roots; passive participle; passive verbs; structures for narration; connective words; conditional sentence.
